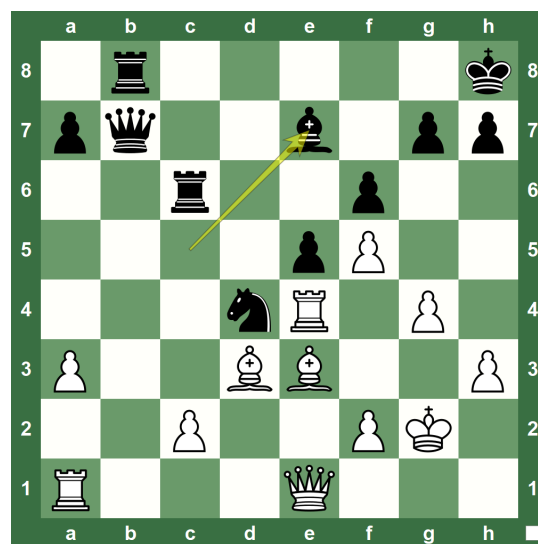
Games From The 2024 August Monster Match.

For years the Chaturanga Chess Club has run its “Monster Match” the week before the club championship. It is a singular creation that is not encountered anywhere else in the local chessaverse. Characterized as a warmup for the club championship, the “MM” used a system where the two highest rated players would alternate picking team mates from the available participants loosely grouped by playing strength to form two teams. The players would then be paired up and they would play a non-rated game. At the end of the night the winning team would get bragging rights. Since then the “MM” has maintained the team concept but has evolved into a rated event where players are placed in descending order by rating with the even numbered players referred to as team “A” and the odd numbered players referred to as team “B”. Color allocation is then determined by a coin toss for each game. 20 players participated in this years version.

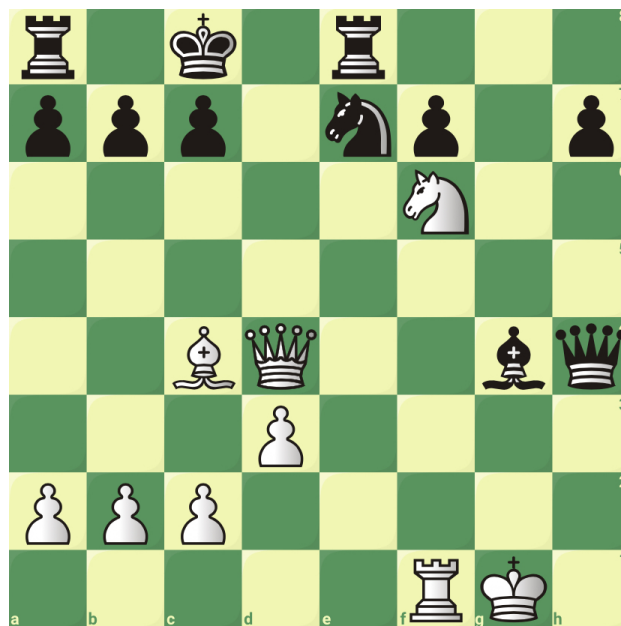

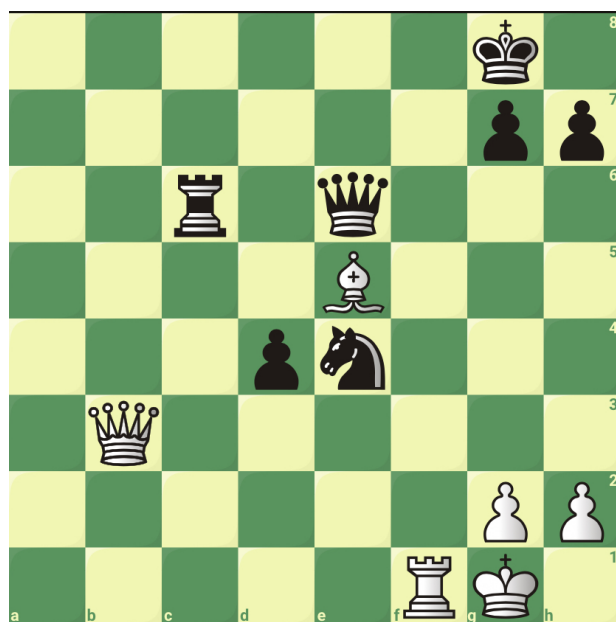

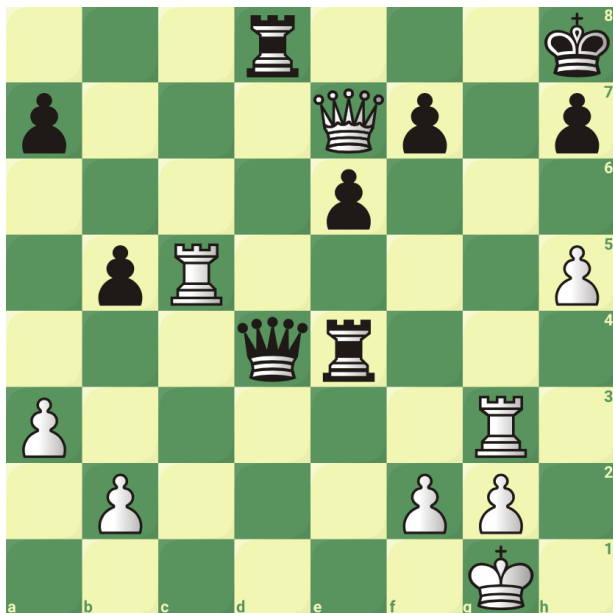
Tactical Motif: Interference

"Interference , as the term indicates, occurs where the defender is forced to block himself. He has a choice of moving two pieces to a critical square. Whichever piece he moves, he blocks the operations of the other piece and is thus left helpless against his opponent's threats."

15. The Recording of Games

15A. Manner of keeping score.

In the course of play each player is required to record the game (both the player's and the opponent's moves), move after move, as clearly and legibly as possible, on the scoresheet prescribed for the competition. Algebraic notation is standard, but descriptive or computer notation is permitted. The player must first make the move, and then record it on the scoresheet. The scoresheet shall be visible to the arbiter (tournament directors) and the opponent throughout the game.
